

8th ECPR Summer School on Interest Group Politics

June 29 – July 07, 2017 | University of Bremen/BIGSSS

Registration | Basic Requirements

The summer school is open to PhD students, advanced master students and postdocs from political science, public administration or related areas. A limited number of practitioners can participate as well. A basic requirement is that all applicants should have completed introductory courses in political and administrative sciences at the BA-level. Students are expected to present parts of their own research, preferably in the form of a research paper (6,000 to 8,000 words). Exceptionally we will also accept project proposals. Students should submit their papers or research proposals by June 15.

Costs

The course fee without accommodation is 200€ and includes course materials. In addition, we have reserved single rooms in the hotel “7THINGS – my basic hotel in Bremen”. You are free to arrange your accommodation independently. Travel costs and costs for food (except breakfast) are not included.

Please submit your **CV**, a **one-page motivation letter** and an **abstract of the paper** you want to present at the Summer School in **one compound PDF-file** to interestgroups2017@bigsss-bremen.de by **May 15, 2017** at the latest. Eligible candidates will be selected on a first-come-first-serve basis and applicants are therefore encouraged to submit their application as early as possible. Once the course is fully booked, we will open a waiting list for late applicants. Your registration will be confirmed once your application is accepted by the Summer School coordinator and your payment is received.

Certification

Successful participants in the Summer School will be fully credited (5 ECTS or equivalent).

Visa Requirements

If in need of a visa for their stay in Germany, students are required to obtain these themselves. Please check the German Embassy in your country for more information on visa-requirements.
